TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to all members of the Springfield USBC WBA. If you are not a member, you may purchase your USBC card through the local association. This tournament will be limited to 80 participants.

MEMBERS OF THE SPRINGFIELD WOMEN'S 600 CLUB WILL HAVE PREFERENCE ON THEIR ENTRY.

2. All 600 Club members must pay their dues of \$6.00 before participating in any 600 Club sponsored tournament. Bowlers who have never bowled a 600 series and are not eligible to be a member of the 600 Club, are not required to pay dues (600 Club Bylaws).
3. All entrants will bowl FOUR (4) GAMES across EIGHT lanes at each center, with six (6) bowlers to a pair of lanes. If participation requires it, additional bowlers will be assigned on lanes. All bowlers will compete on the same set of lanes. Entries will be assigned to a division based on last year's average. A DIVISION II BOWLER MAY CHOOSE TO BOWL IN DIVISION I. If necessary, there will be two (2) squads. Bowlers will alternate starting times and will not be scheduled the same starting time at the same house.

ON THE LAST DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT, BOWLERS WILL BE REASSIGNED SO THAT THE TOP SIX BOWLERS (4 FROM DIVISION I AND 2 FROM DIVISION II WILL BE BOWLING THEIR LAST GAME NEXT TO THE TOP SIX BOWLERS FROM THE MEN'S ROUND THE TOWN.

THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL ACCEPT CHECKS FOR THE TOURNAMENT FEES. ANY BOWLER WRITING AN NSF CHECK WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WRITE FUTURE CHECKS. THAT BOWLER WILL BE ASSESSED ANY PENALTY CHARGES DUE TO THE NSF CHECK.

4. **DIVISION I IS SCRATCH; DIVISION II IS HANDICAP**
NOTE: USBC Rules 319d (reporting of winnings) 319e (15 pin rule) DO NOT APPLY.
5. **PRIZES:** Prize fund monies will be returned 100% in each division. The 600 Club will donate \$200.00 to the prize fund to be divided between the two divisions based on entrants. At least 1 in 5 entries in each division will be paid in prize money. A traveling trophy will be presented to the bowler with the highest total scratch pin count. A championship plaque will be presented to the winner of each division.
6. Entries must be postmarked by midnight on December 31, 2011.
